



Only test are performed in this report. The technology documentations, which should be provided by the manufacturer for the review requirement of IEC 62133, are not included in this report. This battery is constructed with one lithium-ion cell, and has overcharge, over-discharge, over current and short-circuits proof circuit.

The cell consists of the positive electrode plate, negative electrode plate, separator, electrolyte and aluminum plastic film case.
